AN ACT PROHIBITING TAX-EXEMPT STATUS FOR HATE GROUPS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit from eligibility for
- 2 tax-exempt status any organization that foments hatred against an
- 3 individual or a group of people or property owned by such individual
- 4 or group, motivated in whole or in part by race, religion, disability,
- 5 sexual orientation, ethnicity, gender or gender identity.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit from eligibility for tax-exempt status any organization that is a hate group.
