AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXCESS COST GRANT REIMBURSEMENT THRESHOLD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 10-76g of the general statutes be amended to (1) increase 2 the total appropriation for the excess cost grant, and (2) change the 3 reimbursement threshold for the excess cost grant from four and one-4 half times the average per pupil educational costs to a tiered system as 5 follows: (A) Two and one-quarter times the average per pupil 6 educational costs for an alliance district or a school district for a town with a per capita net equalized grand list below one hundred thousand 8 dollars, (B) three times the average per pupil educational costs for a 9 school district for a town with a per capita net equalized grand list at or 10 above one hundred thousand dollars but below two hundred thousand 11 dollars, and (C) three and three-quarters times the average per pupil 12 educational costs for a school district for a town with a per capita net 13 equalized grand list at or above two hundred thousand dollars.
