AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR FACILITY MODERNIZATION AND ARTIFACT PRESERVATION AT THE U.S. COAST GUARD ACADEMY LIBRARY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate one million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Department of Economic and Community Development for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the U.S. Coast Guard Academy Library to modernize facilities and preserve artifacts.
