**AN ACT CONCERNING LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE DISAPPROVAL
OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS ISSUED PURSUANT TO AN EMERGENCY
DECLARATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 19a-131a and 28-9 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 authorize the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 3 cognizance of matters relating to an executive order issued by the
- 4 Governor pursuant to a declaration of a public health or civil
- 5 preparedness emergency to disapprove such executive order, provided
- 6 an equal number of members from the majority party and minority
- 7 party vote in favor of such disapproval.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for equitable review of an executive order by the legislative
committee having cognizance over the subject matter of an executive
order.
