AN ACT PERMITTING PERSONS SIXTEEN YEARS OLD TO DONATE BLOOD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 19a-285a of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2020*):

3 (a) Any person who is seventeen years of age or older shall have the
4 legal capacity, without written authorization of his or her parent or
5 guardian, to donate blood or any component thereof and to consent to
6 the withdrawal of blood from his or her body, in conjunction with any
7 voluntary blood donation program.

8 (b) Any person who is sixteen years of age shall have the legal
9 capacity, with written authorization of his or her parent or guardian, to
10 donate blood or any component thereof and to consent to the
11 withdrawal of blood from his or her body in conjunction with any
12 voluntary blood donation program.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
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Section 1	<i>July 1, 2020</i>	19a-285a
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Statement of Purpose:

To permit persons sixteen years old to donate blood.
