## AN ACT PERMITTING PERSONS SIXTEEN YEARS OLD TO DONATE BLOOD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 19a-285a of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2020*):
- 3 (a) Any person who is seventeen years of age or older shall have the
- 4 legal capacity, without written authorization of his or her parent or
- 5 guardian, to donate blood or any component thereof and to consent to
- 6 the withdrawal of blood from his or her body, in conjunction with any
- 7 voluntary blood donation program.
- 8 (b) Any person who is sixteen years of age shall have the legal
- 9 capacity, with written authorization of his or her parent or guardian, to
- 10 donate blood or any component thereof and to consent to the
- 11 <u>withdrawal of blood from his or her body in conjunction with any</u>
- voluntary blood donation program.
