AN ACT CONCERNING THE SHORTAGE OF CERTAIN DRUGS PRESCRIBED TO TREAT TYPE II DIABETES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) The Commissioner of
- 2 Consumer Protection shall adopt regulations, in accordance with the
- 3 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, to ensure that there is a
- 4 sufficient supply of dulaglutide and semaglutide to treat patients in
- 5 this state who have been diagnosed with type II diabetes. Such
- 6 regulations may, among other things, provide that no pharmacist shall
- 7 dispense dulaglutide or semaglutide to treat any condition for which
- 8 dulaglutide or semaglutide has not been approved by the federal Food
- 9 and Drug Administration while such drug is in short supply in this
- 10 state. For the purposes of this section, "dispense", "drug" and
- 11 "pharmacist" have the same meanings as provided in section 20-571 of
- 12 the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
