AN ACT CONCERNING TRAVEL INSURANCE AND SUICIDE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to prohibit insurance
- 2 companies that issue travel insurance policies in this state from
- 3 excluding coverage because the insured or the insured's spouse, child,
- 4 dependent relative who resides in the insured's household or traveling
- 5 companion commits suicide.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit insurance companies that issue travel insurance policies in this state from excluding coverage because the insured or the insured's spouse, child, dependent relative who resides in the insured's household or traveling companion commits suicide.
