AN ACT REQUIRING THE USE OF HELMETS BY MOTORCYCLE OPERATORS AND PASSENGERS UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-289g of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 motorcycle operators and passengers under twenty-one years of age,
- 3 rather than under eighteen years of age, to wear protective headgear.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce serious injuries and fatalities by requiring motorcycle operators and passengers under twenty-one years of age to wear helmets.
