**AN ACT CONCERNING CAREER TRAINING PROGRAMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require (1) the Department
- 2 of Education to (A) establish a rubric for career pathway training
- 3 programs, and (B) develop a new accelerated pathway to teacher
- 4 certification for people working in trades; (2) distribution of information
- 5 concerning vocational agriculture programs, technical education and
- 6 vocational opportunities to students in middle schools; and (3) each
- 7 local or regional board of education and technical education and career
- 8 school to present to students, during any presentation related to the
- 9 completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, the
- 10 opportunities associated with attending trade school.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To develop programs and present information related to trade schools at middle schools and high schools.
