AN ACT CONCERNING HOMEMAKER AND COMPANION SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) allow a registry, in
- 2 addition to a homemaker-companion agency, to conduct background
- 3 checks on prospective employees, (2) expand the contents of the
- 4 required notice to a consumer regarding homemaker and companion
- 5 services, and (3) modify provisions on covenants not to compete
- 6 between an individual and a homemaker-companion agency, registry
- 7 or home health aide agency.

Statement of Purpose:

To better protect individuals using homemaker and companion services.
