AN ACT CONCERNING LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT ACCREDITATION AND STANDARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-294ee of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- the requirement that each law enforcement unit obtain and maintain
 accreditation by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement
 Agencies, Inc. beginning on January 1, 2025, and permit such units to
- 5 meet either the standards set by the commission or the Police Officer
- 6 Standards and Training Council.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow law enforcement units to comply with either the standards of the Police Officer Standards and Training Council or the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies.
