**AN ACT PROVIDING CERTAIN BENEFITS TO HMONG LAOTIAN  
SPECIAL GUERRILLA UNITS WHO SERVED IN THE KINGDOM OF  
LAOS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide the following
- 2 benefits to members of the Hmong Laotian special guerilla units who
- 3 served in the secret war in the Kingdom of Laos during the Vietnam
- 4 War: (1) Special certificate of registration and a set of numbered plates
- 5 for motor vehicles; (2) listed as a veteran on motor vehicle operators'
- 6 licenses; (3) funeral expenses paid by the state for members with
- 7 insufficient funds; (4) burial in a veterans' cemetery; and (5) a medal and
- 8 ribbon issued by the Commissioner of Veterans Affairs.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide certain benefits to members of the Hmong Laotian special guerilla units who served in the secret war in the Kingdom of Laos during the Vietnam War.
