AN ACT CONCERNING RENT STABILITY AND NO-FAULT EVICTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 47a of the general statutes be amended to prohibit rent
- 2 increases that exceed two and one-half per cent on an annual basis and
- 3 to establish rules for no-fault evictions and exceptions for such evictions.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide stability for renters in the state by capping annual rent increases and establishing rules for no-fault evictions.
