## AN ACT REVISING A MOTOR VEHICLE STATUTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 14-11j of the 2020 supplement to the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective* 

3 *October 1, 2020*):

The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, in consultation with the 4 5 Connecticut Police Chiefs Association and at least one organization that 6 advocates for persons with autism spectrum disorder, shall design and 7 make available blue envelopes that (1) provide written information and 8 guidance on the outside of the envelopes regarding ways to enhance 9 effective communication between a police officer and a person with 10 autism spectrum disorder, and (2) are capable of holding a person's 11 vehicle operator's license, registration and insurance motor 12 identification card. On and after January 1, 2020, upon request by a 13 person with autism spectrum disorder, or if such person is a minor, such 14 person's parent or guardian, the commissioner shall provide a blue 15 envelope designed pursuant to this section to such person, parent or 16 guardian.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
