AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR GRANTS-IN-AID TO HOME HEALTH AGENCIES TO PURCHASE SAFETY, TRACKING AND COMMUNICATIONS DEVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Department of Public Health for the purpose of providing grants-in-aid to home health agencies for the purchase of safety, tracking and communications devices for home care workers.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to home health agencies to purchase safety, tracking and communications devices to improve communication with and protect home care workers.
