AN ACT AUTHORIZING RECIPROCAL LICENSING FOR CERTAIN OUT-OF-STATE HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to allow physicians, physical

2 therapists, occupational therapists, alcohol and drug counselors,

3 radiographers, radiologic technologists, radiologist assistants and

nuclear medicine technologists, nurses, nurse's aides, dentists, dental

5 hygienists, respiratory care practitioners, behavior analysts,

6 psychologists, marital and family therapists, clinical social workers and

7 master social workers, professional counselors, genetic counselors,

8 music therapists, art therapists, dietician-nutritionists, emergency

9 medical services personnel, speech and language pathologists and

10 pharmacists who are appropriately licensed, certified or registered in

another state or territory of the United States or the District of Columbia

12 to practice in this state within the scope of the profession for which such

13 providers are licensed, certified or registered.

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Statement of Purpose:

To authorize reciprocal licensing for certain out-of-state health care providers.

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
