AN ACT DEVELOPING AN INCENTIVE PROGRAM TO RETAIN HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS WHO ARE EDUCATED OR TRAINED IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to develop an incentive
- 2 program to retain in the state health care providers who are educated or
- 3 trained in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To alleviate the health care provider shortage by retaining in the state physicians, nurses and other health care providers who are educated or trained in the state.
