AN ACT EXEMPTING SMALL BUSINESSES FROM CERTAIN FEES DURING THE COVID-PANDEMIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That small businesses be exempted from paying licensure or
- 2 permitting fees to the state until the Commissioner of Public Health
- 3 declares the COVID-19 pandemic to be over.
