AN ACT REQUIRING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TUITION REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM FOR MENTAL HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner of
- 2 Public Health to establish a tuition reimbursement program for mental
- 3 health care providers who commit to practice in the state for a specified
- 4 period of time.

Statement of Purpose:

To address the shortage of mental health professionals in the state.
