AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that a portion of
- 2 opioid settlement funds be used to (1) establish a public awareness
- 3 campaign on the dangers of fentanyl, and (2) provide Narcan to school
- 4 districts that choose to keep it in their schools.

Statement of Purpose:

To combat the fentanyl crisis in the state.
