AN ACT ALLOWING OUT-OF-STATE TELEHEALTH PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE TELEHEALTH SERVICES TO PATIENTS IN THIS STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (12) of subsection (a) of section 19a-906 of the
- 2 general statutes be amended to establish that the requirements for
- 3 licensure, certification or registration of telehealth providers include
- 4 out-of-state telehealth providers who are Medicaid-enrolled providers
- 5 or in-network providers for commercially, fully insured health
- 6 insurance providing telehealth services to patients.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish that the requirements for licensure, certification or registration of telehealth providers include out-of-state telehealth providers who are Medicaid-enrolled providers or in-network providers for commercially, fully insured health insurance providing telehealth services to patients.

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
