AN ACT CONCERNING TELEHEALTH SERVICES AND HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR SUCH SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to expand: (1) Provisions
- 2 concerning the provision of telehealth services by health care providers;
- 3 and (2) health insurance coverage for such services to include coverage
- 4 for services rendered by chiropractors, physical therapists, naturopaths
- 5 and optometrists.
