AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY REGARDING THE USE OF AN ONLINE SOFTWARE APPLICATION TO ADDRESS THE MENTAL HEALTH NEEDS OF STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (Effective July 1, 2024) The Department of Education shall 2 conduct a study to determine the feasibility of permitting local and 3 regional boards of education to utilize in schools in the state an online 4 software application that is designed to address the mental health needs 5 of students by providing student users access to mental health 6 professionals while maintaining the anonymity of such student users. 7 Not later than January 1, 2025, the department shall submit such 8 feasibility study and any recommendations to the joint standing 9 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters 10 relating to children, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a 11 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 July 1, 2024 New section

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Education to conduct a study of the feasibility of using an online mental health needs software application in schools.
