AN ACT CONCERNING A MILITARY PERMIT FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Section 30-34 of the general statutes is repealed and the
 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2020*):
- A military permit shall allow the retail sale of [beer] <u>alcoholic liquor</u> at any camp or military installation used and controlled by the
- 5 Connecticut National Guard or the state guard, for on or off premises
- 6 <u>consumption</u>. The annual fee for a military permit shall be thirty dollars.
