AN ACT CONCERNING A MILITARY PERMIT FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 30-34 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2020*):

3 A military permit shall allow the retail sale of [beer] alcoholic liquor
4 at any camp or military installation used and controlled by the
5 Connecticut National Guard or the state guard, for on or off premises
6 consumption. The annual fee for a military permit shall be thirty dollars.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
