## AN ACT INCREASING THE THRESHOLD FOR SEALED BIDDING ON CERTAIN MUNICIPAL CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 7-148v of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective October
- 3 1, 2024):
- 4 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of any municipal charter or any 5 special act to the contrary, any municipality may, by ordinance, 6 establish requirements for competitive bidding for the award of any
- 7 contract or the purchase of any real or personal property by the
- 8 municipality. Such ordinance may provide that, except as otherwise
- 9 required by any provision of the general statutes, sealed bidding shall
- 10 not be required for contracts or purchases having a value less than or
- 11 equal to an amount established in the ordinance, which amount shall
- 12 not be greater than [twenty-five] <u>fifty</u> thousand dollars. Nothing in this
- 13 section shall be deemed to invalidate any ordinance enacted by a
- 14 municipality prior to October 1, 1989. Nothing in this section and no
- ordinance adopted pursuant to this section shall be construed to limit

- 16 the ability of a municipality to enter into a contract pursuant to section
- 17 4a-53a.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

## Statement of Purpose:

To increase the threshold for sealed bidding on municipal contracts for the purchase of real and personal property from twenty-five thousand dollars to fifty thousand dollars.
