AN ACT PHASING OUT THE SALE AND MANUFACTURE OF COSMETICS THAT USE ANIMAL TESTING IN THEIR DEVELOPMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to phase out the sale and
- 2 manufacture of cosmetics that utilize animal testing in any phase of
- 3 their development.
