## AN ACT CONCERNING MILITARY LEAVE PROVISIONS UNDER THE STATE PERSONNEL ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 5-248 of the general statutes is
repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*, 2024):

4 (c) Any full-time permanent employee in the state service who is a member of the armed forces of the state or of any reserve component of 5 the armed forces of the United States and is required to [undergo field] 6 7 perform ordered military training therein shall, for [the period not 8 exceeding three calendar weeks] not more than fifteen days per year of 9 such [field] <u>military</u> training, be entitled to a leave of absence with pay 10 in addition to his annual vacation. Nothing in this section shall be 11 construed to prevent any such employee from attending ordered 12 [annual field] military training while on regularly scheduled vacation if 13 he so desires.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
