**AN ACT CONCERNING DEADLINES FOR MAILINGS IN ANY
PROVISION OF THE GENERAL STATUTES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2020*) Notwithstanding any
- 2 provision of the general statutes, any person receiving a document by
- 3 mail shall accept a postmark, as described in section 1-2a of the general
- 4 statutes, as evidence of the sender's compliance with any deadline for
- 5 mailing a document under any provision of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To provide that the postmark date of mailing shall be valid for any statutory deadline.
