AN ACT REDUCING FARES FOR BUS PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2024*) Any person who is a veteran, as defined in subsection (a) of section 27-103 of the general statutes, shall be eligible to pay fifty per cent of the lawful charge for state-owned or controlled bus public transportation service, provided such person presents to the fare inspector, as defined in section 13b-2 of the general statutes, or the driver of such bus, as applicable, a motor vehicle operator's license or identity card indicating such person's status as a veteran in accordance with subsection (e) of section 14-36h of the general

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
