**AN ACT EXPANDING ELIGIBILITY FOR THE ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE
RESPITE CARE PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-349e of the general statutes be amended to raise the
- 2 income level at which a person is eligible for the Alzheimer's disease
- 3 respite care program and remove the condition that expanding
- 4 eligibility be based on available appropriations.
