AN ACT ALLOWING AN EMERGENCY CONTACT ACCESS TO A DWELLING UNIT WITHOUT THE TENANT'S CONSENT UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 47a-16 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2020*):
- 3 (a) A tenant shall not unreasonably withhold consent to the landlord
- 4 to enter into the dwelling unit in order to inspect the premises, make
- 5 necessary or agreed to repairs, alterations or improvements, supply
- 6 necessary or agreed to services or exhibit the dwelling unit to
- 7 prospective or actual purchasers, mortgagees, tenants, workmen or
- 8 contractors.
- 9 (b) A landlord may enter the dwelling unit without consent of the
- 10 tenant in case of emergency.
- 11 (c) A landlord shall not abuse the right of entry or use such right of
- 12 entry to harass the tenant. The landlord shall give the tenant reasonable
- 13 written or oral notice of his intent to enter and may enter only at

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- 14 reasonable times, except in case of emergency.
- 15 (d) (1) A landlord may not enter the dwelling unit without the
- 16 consent of the tenant except [(1)] (A) in case of emergency, [(2)] (B) as
- permitted by section 47a-16a, [(3)] (C) pursuant to a court order, [or (4)]
- 18 (D) if the tenant has abandoned or surrendered the premises, or (E) as
- 19 permitted by subdivision (2) of this subsection.
- 20 (2) A landlord shall provide a person designated as an emergency
- 21 contact by a tenant with access to the tenant's dwelling unit for the
- 22 purpose of checking the well-being of the tenant if the landlord is
- 23 unable, after making reasonable efforts, to contact the tenant and obtain
- 24 consent to enter the unit.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To allow a person designated as an emergency contact of a tenant of a dwelling unit to access the unit under certain circumstances.
