AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PILOT PROGRAM TO ESTABLISH A PIPELINE FOR STUDENTS TO ENROLL IN CT AERO TECH SCHOOL FOR AVIATION MAINTENANCE TECHNICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to require (1) the

2 Technical Education and Career System to develop a pilot program that

3 may be used by local and regional boards of education to establish a

4 pipeline for students to enroll in CT Aero Tech School for Aviation

5 Maintenance Technicians in which a board may partner with one or

6 more local businesses and stakeholders to offer on-site training and

7 course credit to students, and (2) the superintendent of the Technical

8 Education and Career System to submit a report concerning the number

9 of students, businesses and stakeholders participating in the pilot

10 program and any recommendations for legislation to increase

11 participation in the program to the joint standing committee of the

12 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to education

13 not later than January 1, 2025.
