AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Commissioner of Social
- 2 Services shall study the efficacy of Medicaid programs and whether the
- 3 state can expand health care services to low-income individuals through
- 4 additional Medicaid waiver programs.
- 5 (b) Not later than January 1, 2023, the commissioner shall submit a
- 6 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
- 7 statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
- 8 having cognizance of matters relating to human services. The report
- 9 shall include, but need not be limited to (1) a list of Medicaid waiver
- 10 programs in the state and the number of individuals served, (2) waiting
- 11 lists for each waiver program, and (3) recommendations concerning
- 12 additional waiver programs the state should consider.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 from passage New section

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Statement of Purpose:

To study the efficacy of Medicaid programs.
