AN ACT CONCERNING TEACHERS WHO ARE CERTIFIED IN OTHER STATES AND CERTIFICATION APPLICATION FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-146c of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Education to accept the certification of teachers who
- 3 are licensed or certified, in good standing, in another state and that
- 4 subsection (l) of section 10-145b of the general statutes be amended to
- 5 require that all certification application fees be in an amount not more
- 6 than fifty dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Education to accept the certification of teachers who are certified in good standing in another state and to cap certification application fees at fifty dollars.
