AN ACT CONCERNING A MINIMUM RECYCLED GLASS CONTENT FOR WINE AND LIQUOR BOTTLES SOLD OR DISTRIBUTED IN THE NORTHEAST REGION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) Not later than October 1, 2 2020, the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection shall 3 convene a collective of representatives of each New England state who 4 oversee solid waste management in their respective states for the 5 purpose of establishing a minimum recycled glass content for glass wine 6 and liquor bottles sold and distributed in such New England states on 7 and after October 1, 2021. Not later than December 1, 2020, the 8 commissioner, in accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, 9 shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the General 10 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment on the result of such collective and shall include recommendations for any 11 12 legislative proposals in support of the work and recommendations of 13 such collective. In the event that the collective described in this section 14 does not agree upon such a minimum recycled glass content for such 15 glass wine and liquor bottles sold in the New England region, the

16 commissioner shall include in such report a recommendation for a 17 minimum recycled glass content for such glass wine and liquor bottles 18 sold or distributed in this state, a suggested implementation date for 19 such requirement and any legislative recommendations for the 20 implementation of an extended producer responsibility program to 21 support the achievement and eventual increase of such minimum 22 recycled glass content requirement.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to convene a collective of New England states for the purpose of establishing a minimum recycled content for glass wine and liquor bottles sold in the region.
