## AN ACT REQUIRING THE PROVISION OF ALL-TERRAIN WHEELCHAIRS AT STATE PARKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2023) (a) Not later than October 1,
- 2 2023, the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection shall
- 3 select five state parks or campground facilities for the availability of
- 4 all-terrain wheelchairs to patrons of such parks or campground
- 5 facilities. Each park or campground facility selected by the department
- 6 shall host two such all-terrain wheelchairs that shall be made available
- 7 for use to park or campground facility patrons free of charge. Such all-
- 8 terrain wheelchairs shall be made available to such patrons, in
- 9 accordance with the provisions of this section, not later than April 1,
- 10 2024.
- 11 (b) The Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection may
- 12 establish rules for the hours of availability of such all-terrain
- 13 wheelchairs in each such park or campground facility, as well as
- 14 procedures and requirements for reserving, requesting the use of and
- 15 operating such an all-terrain wheelchair in such state park or
- 16 campground facility.

(c) Not later than January 1, 2025, the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment concerning the use of such all-terrain wheelchairs in such state parks or campground facilities. Such report shall include, but not be limited to: (1) Information on the number of patrons that used such all-terrain wheelchairs at each such state park or campground facility since the implementation of the requirements of this section, (2) a description of any problems or concerns that arose as a result of the availability of such all-terrain wheelchairs pursuant to this section, (3) recommendations as to the sufficiency of providing two such all-terrain wheelchairs for each state park or campground facility, and (4) suggestions for the expansion of such availability of allterrain wheelchairs at additional state parks or campground facilities throughout the state.

(d) For purposes of this section, "all-terrain wheelchair" means a battery-powered wheelchair that has treads capable of traversing trails, sand, gravel and similar rugged terrain or ground cover.
