AN ACT REDUCING PARTICIPANT COSTS AND INCREASING ASSET LIMITS FOR THE CONNECTICUT HOME-CARE PROGRAM FOR THE ELDERLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-342 of the general statutes be amended to: (1)
- 2 Decrease the amount participants in the Connecticut home-care
- 3 program for the elderly must pay for their care, and (2) expand asset
- 4 limits for such program to forty thousand dollars for individuals and
- 5 sixty-five thousand dollars for married couples.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce participant costs and expand eligibility for home care services for persons sixty-five years of age or older.

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
