**AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPORTATION SERVICES PROVIDED
BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO STUDENTS AT
INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 13b-34 of the general statutes is amended by adding
2 subsection (l) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (NEW) (l) The commissioner may contract with any institution of
4 higher education in the state to provide transportation services to
5 students enrolled at such institution. At a minimum, such contract shall
6 specify (1) the effective dates of the transportation passes provided to
7 such institution from the department to be issued to every student for
8 any semester or academic year, (2) the terms of use of a transportation
9 pass by each student, (3) the specific transportation services on which
10 students may use a transportation pass, (4) the terms of payment to the
11 department by the institution for the provision of such transportation
12 services, and (5) any other terms or conditions deemed necessary by the
13 commissioner to carry out the provisions of this subsection. For the
14 purpose of this subsection, "transportation pass" means a ticket, pass or

15 other documentation that shows compliance by the passenger with
16 transportation fare payment requirements.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
