AN ACT REQUIRING PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFICIARIES TO WORK OR VOLUNTEER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require ablebodied, adult recipients of public assistance, including, but not limited to, supplemental nutrition assistance, state-administered general assistance and Medicaid, to work or volunteer for a minimum of twenty hours weekly.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote work among able-bodied recipients of public assistance.
