**AN ACT EXTENDING TEMPORARY FAMILY ASSISTANCE TO
ENCOURAGE EMPLOYMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-112 of the general statutes be amended to extend
- 2 by up to twelve months the provision of temporary family assistance if
- 3 a participant finds a job that exceeds ninety per cent of the program's
- 4 payment standard.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage recipients of temporary family assistance to find employment by allowing them to retain benefits for not more than twelve months if they find a job that exceeds ninety per cent of the temporary family assistance payment standard.
