AN ACT CONCERNING A WORK REQUIREMENT FOR YOUNG ADULT MEDICAID BENEFICIARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Social Services to seek a federal Medicaid waiver that
- 3 would require Medicaid beneficiaries between the ages of twenty and
- 4 thirty to work twenty hours weekly without fear of losing Medicaid
- 5 benefits.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce barriers to employment for young adult Medicaid beneficiaries who are able to obtain work but fear losing benefits.
