***AN ACT CUTTING OFF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FOR PERSONS WHO  
LEAVE THE STATE FOR MORE THAN THIRTY DAYS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1      That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require that any
- 2      recipient of public assistance who is absent from the state for more
- 3      than thirty days loses public assistance and that such absence
- 4      establishes a rebuttable presumption of abandonment of Connecticut
- 5      residency.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To prohibit public assistance for persons who leave the state for more than thirty days.
