AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY RESPONSE BY TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANIES AFTER OUTAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to extend the 2 provisions of public 20-5 to companies act providing 3 telecommunications service or Internet service and to require such 4 companies to provide residential customers a credit of one hundred 5 dollars for each full day a service outage occurs.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote accountability for service outages and to protect consumers of Internet and telecommunications services.
