AN ACT REQUIRING THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER TO STUDY REIMBURSEMENT PARITY FOR PODIATRISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Insurance Commissioner
- 2 shall study the feasibility and anticipated impact of prohibiting insurers,
- 3 health care centers, hospital service corporations, medical service
- 4 corporations, fraternal benefit societies and other entities doing health
- 5 insurance business in this state from paying a reduced reimbursement
- 6 to a licensed health care provider who provides a covered benefit that is
- 7 in such provider's scope of practice because such provider is a
- 8 podiatrist.
- 9 (b) Not later than January 1, 2021, the Insurance Commissioner shall
- submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
- general statutes, on the commissioner's findings to the joint standing
- 12 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 13 relating to insurance.

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This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
