AN ACT CONCERNING ROAD REPAIR BY PUBLIC UTILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 283 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 any public utility that cuts, excavates or alters a public highway shall
- 3 repair or repave such highway to the satisfaction of the local authority
- 4 having jurisdiction over the maintenance of such highway. The local
- 5 authority may require the public utility to reconstruct the highway from
- 6 curb to curb wherever a utility cut, excavation or alteration exists
- 7 between the curbs.

Statement of Purpose:

To require public utilities to repave or repair roads that have been altered or excavated by a public utility to the satisfaction of the local authority controlling the roadway.
