## AN ACT EXPANDING THE ELIGIBILITY FOR GRANTS TO REMOVE PEAS FROM FIRE APPARATUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision (10) of subsection (b) of section 41 of public act
- 2 23-204 is repealed and the following is substitute in lieu thereof (*Effective*
- 3 from passage):
- 4 (10) The sum of \$3,000,000 to the Department of Emergency Services
- 5 and Public Protection, for Other Expenses, for the fiscal year ending
- 6 June 30, 2024, to provide grants to municipalities, independent fire
- 7 <u>companies and state agencies</u> to remove PFAS from fire apparatus <u>or</u>
- 8 provide reimbursement for removal of PFAS from fire apparatus that
- 9 occurred prior to July 1, 2023;
- Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) Any funds remaining under subdivision
- 11 (10) of subsection (b) of section 41 of public act 23-204, as amended by
- 12 this act, at the conclusion of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, shall
- 13 not lapse on June 30, 2024, and such funds shall be available to the
- 14 Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, for Other

- 15 Expenses, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, to provide grants to
- 16 municipalities, independent fire companies and state agencies to
- 17 remove PFAS from fire apparatus or provide reimbursement for
- 18 removal of PFAS from fire apparatus that occurred prior to July 1, 2023.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following		
sections:
