AN ACT CONCERNING THE FILING OF DISCRIMINATION AND HARASSMENT COMPLAINTS WITH THE SUPERIOR COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 814c of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 an individual who alleges that he or she has been discriminated
- 3 against or harassed may bring an action directly to the Superior Court
- 4 and need not initially bring such action to the Commission on Human
- 5 Rights and Opportunities.

Statement of Purpose:

To expedite access to justice for those claiming discrimination and harassment.
