## AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CONNECTICUT INDUSTRIAL HISTORY TRAIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2021) The Department of 2 Economic and Community Development shall, within available 3 appropriations, establish a Connecticut industrial history trail to 4 identify and market historical industrial sites throughout the state. The 5 department shall develop criteria to identify major historical industrial 6 sites, associated companies and museums concerning the state's 7 industrial history. The department shall develop a program that 8 promotes the industrial history trail, including, but not limited to, (1) 9 directional and other signage and notices pertaining to the sites 10 identified by the department, and (2) an industrial history trail Internet 11 web site.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
